Connor had a way with words and loved fun times with family and friends. He adored all forms of transport, especially buses. He was also learning disabled and had autism and epilepsy. On 4 July 2013, aged eighteen, he drowned in a bath in a closed hospital unit where he was a temporary patient. An independent inquiry said that his death was preventable, and his inquest concluded that neglect was a contributory factor to his death. The hospital unit was closed because of poor standards of care.

The quilt was made by Janet Read, Janis Firminger, Margaret Taylor and Jean Draper from hundreds of small patches of cloth contributed by people who wanted to support Connor's family in their efforts to find out the truth about what happened to him.
